	<ul> <li><u>Additional vehicle requirements:</u></li> <li>Conditional registration of All Terrain Vehicles (ATVs) is only available in circumstance where the vehicle meets the following general conditions:</li> <li>Will be used mostly off-road or off road-related areas, but needs limited access the road network;</li> <li>Limited mixing with general traffic on sealed roads; and</li> <li>Will be floated from site to site, unless a designated route or area of operations has been approved by the RTA.</li> <li>ATVs can be conditionally registered if they meet the general conditions above.</li> <li>The following circumstances are considered to meet these conditions:</li> <li>Use by primary producers for farming purposes.</li> </ul>			
	<ul> <li>Use on Stockton Beach for recreational purposes.</li> </ul>			
	<ul> <li>Use by Surf Life Saving Clubs on their specific beach.</li> </ul>			
	<ul> <li>Ose by surf Life saving Clubs on their specific beach.</li> <li>By Rural Lands Protection Boards for Board work,</li> </ul>

	<ul><li>All seating positions (unless saddle type seats) must be fitted with at least a lap type set belt. Rear mudguards/flaps must be fitted when used on road or road-related areas.</li><li>All lighting must be fitted as near as possible to the position specified in Schedule 4 of the Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Regulation 1998.</li></ul>

	<ul> <li>Additional mandatory conditions for weed spraying:</li> <li>Weed spraying by councils with speed limited to 40km/h.</li> <li>Must not be used within 3 metres of the sealed/formed road, except for the purpose of crossing a road/loading/unloading.</li> </ul>
